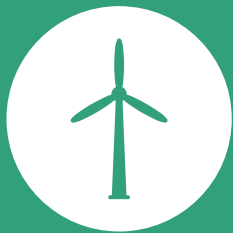

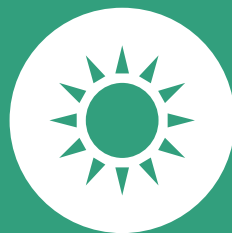

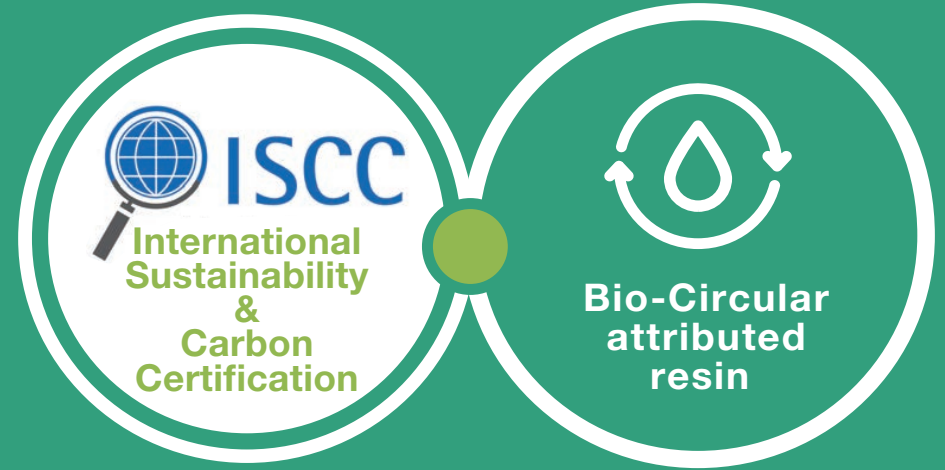

Responsible packaging



- No use of 'single use' plastic bags on our chair mat ranges.
- Delivery in rolled, folded or flat formats maximizes transport fuel efficiencies for a reduced carbon footprint.
- In the EU our product packaging contains up to 90% recycled content.
- In the USA our product packaging contains up to 30% recycled content.



Efficient use of natural resources to minimise power consumption creates a reduced carbon footprint.

Responsible packaging manufacture & suppliers

- Our Logistics Facility in Germany works closely with the ALBA Group, one of the leading recycling and environmental services companies as well as raw material providers worldwide.
- Operating with its two brands – ALBA and Interseroh – within Germany, Europe and Asia in 2020, the ALBA Group avoided 3.5 million tonnes of greenhouse gas emissions
- At the same time, the ALBA Group conserved 28.8 million tonnes of primary resources which did not have to be taken from the environment, transported and processed.
